## **PUBLICATION SCHEME**

**(Adopted September 10th, 2015)**

Additional assistance will be available for those with disabilities.

(The council may, however, request donations towards the cost of printing, paper and postage should large volumes of hard copy documents be requested.)

NB: Information held by the council that is not published under this scheme can be requested in writing, when its provision will be considered in accordance with the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act.
