GRANTS POLICY

(Adopted October 8th, 2015)

The council has only a small income for all its work for the community and with this in mind will only award its limited grants budget to individuals or for activities that will benefit the residents of Standish.

The amount of any award made will be at the council's discretion.

Applicants should note that grants will not be awarded to commercial ventures, party political activities, or to other public sector bodies e.g. schools, hospitals, although voluntary groups associated with such public bodies may apply.

For grants in excess of £100 the latest set of annual accounts showing the organisations' income, expenditure and level of balances should be submitted to the council **with the below form.** (If accounts are not available please enclose copies of the latest six months bank statements.)

The form should then be returned to the council clerk.
